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The journal publishes original and interdisciplinary studies related to on the origins and developments of right and left-wing Totalitarianism in Romania, Europe and elsewhere, thus making them available to a broad scientific community across borders.

The journal publishes original papers, conceptual frameworks, studies, documents, testimonies, biographies, glossary terms and book reviews in Romanian, French, and English. It also publishes translations of scientific contributions submitted by Czech, Hungarian, Polish, Russian and Slovakian scholars.

ARHIVELE TOTALITARISMULUI/TOTALITARIANISM ARCHIVES journal is a place for meetings between researchers, university lecturers, PhD candidates and the general public interested in the history of totalitarianism.

The journal publishes information about various academic events related to the study of totalitarianism and the scientific activity of the NIST: reviews of international conferences, congresses.

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
